Dear Year 6 Parents/Carers,

We are writing to give you the final details for the end of Key Stage 2 National Assessments (SATs). The six formal tests take place over four mornings, starting at 9am. The timetable is as follows:

Date	Tests
Monday 12 May	English grammar, punctuation and spelling: Paper 1: questions
Monday 12 May	English grammar, punctuation and spelling: Paper 2: spelling
Tuesday 13 May	English reading
Wednesday 14 May	Mathematics: Paper 1: arithmetic
Wednesday 14 May	Mathematics: Paper 2: reasoning
Thursday 15 May	Mathematics Paper 3: reasoning

It is essential that your child attends all of these tests to ensure that they have a final assessment for Year 6. Furthermore, it is important that they are ready to perform at their optimum level each morning. To achieve this, we would like your support in the following ways:

- Please ensure your child has no late nights because a good regular sleep pattern is essential.
- Ensure they eat well and drink plenty of fluids.

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- Ensure your child has their glasses (if needed) and water bottle in school each day. If your child requires medication, please ensure this is administered each morning.

Toast, croissants, pain au chocolates and fruit will be available for the children to enjoy throughout the week, ending with a bacon sandwich to celebrate the last day of SATs.
