As part of our 'Invaders' topic we are having a Roman Wow Day on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> May.

We will welcome an exclusive visitor from the Roman Britain Schools Workshop, who will be leading an exciting day for the children. He will set up a Roman camp on school grounds and children will experience what life was like in Roman times, particularly for soldiers. They will sign up and become legionaries for the morning, experiencing camp jobs and learning Roman games. They will get to try some Roman hardtack – a lentil stew. Throughout the day, they will also get the chance to be history detectives and handle Roman artefacts trying to work out what they are and what their purpose was. To end the day, all the children will be put through some authentic legionary training where they will handle a Roman shield and learn how to march and create different formations all in Latin.

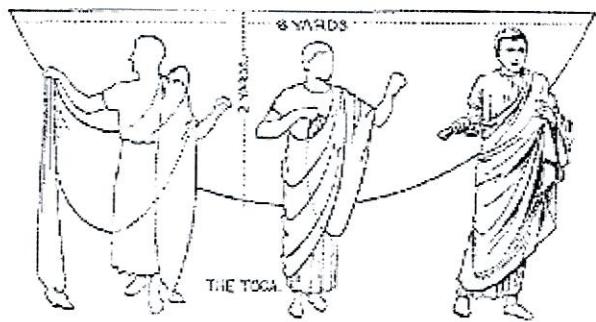
We encourage the children to dress up in clothes that represent the Romans to make this experience memorable and meaningful. The WOW day will engage the children and offer an insight into how people lived.
