Dear Year 4 Parents/Carers,

Overnight Camp: 6th – 8th May 2026

With just over 5 weeks left until we go on Camp, we are very much looking forward to taking your children to Hill House in collaboration with Worle Village Primary School. We enclose the final arrangements and kit list for our two-night stay and an Essential Information Form.

The Essential Information Form needs to be **returned by Wednesday 22nd April** to your child's class teacher to allow us time to check them through. Please ensure you also give details of any additional information that you feel we need to know, particularly regarding medication and medical conditions. **All medication should be handed in on the morning of departure, clearly labelled and with full instructions.** If you have any concerns regarding medication or any other health issues, please contact your child's class teacher to discuss this in detail.

Please ensure **all items of kit are named** to avoid lots of lost property. Your child will need to be able to carry their own bag so please consider the size and weight carefully.

Your child will need a packed lunch for the first day, although all other meals, fruit and drinks are provided. On our return from camp on the Friday, you are welcome to either pick your child up early or, if they are remaining in school, please remember to book a school packed lunch via Aspens or drop one into school in the morning. We will not return in time for a school hot meal.

Please inform us of any dietary and medical needs on the Essential Information Form. We are catering ourselves so we can ensure that no child goes hungry (unless they are too fussy!).

There are strict rules about no eating in the rooms, so please do not sneak in any midnight snacks or sweets as they will be confiscated. There will be an opportunity in the day for the children to visit the tuck shop on site to buy treats. If you wish your child to bring pocket money, please put it in a named wallet or envelope and hand it in to the teacher with the medication on the Wednesday morning (£5 max).
