

English

Throughout the next two terms we will be engaging in:

- ⇒ Creating our own verses of Roman poetry using the poem 'I am a Roman Soldier' by Josiah Wedgewood
- ⇒ Writing stories based around the book 'King of the Cloud Forest' by Michael Morpurgo.
- ⇒ Writing non-chronological reports about Romans and their ways of life.
- ⇒ Creating newspaper reports about the Anglo Saxon invasions of Britain
- ⇒ Creating news reporter scripts about the Viking invasions of Britain
- ⇒ Researching Viking Longships and creating explanation texts.

PE

The focus for these terms will be Tennis and Cricket/Rounders with the sports coaches. In the teacher led sessions we will focus on athletics and orienteering.

Art and Design Technology

In term 5 the children will research Roman pottery and design and make clay pots. In term 6 they will use the skills of back stitch, running stitch and blanket stitch to create a Roman Standard.

PSHE

In PSHE, our units will be Relationships and Changing Me.

Computing

The children will begin by exploring powerpoint and how to create slideshows using animations. In Term 6 the children will be looking at audio production where they will record and edit audio. They will get the opportunity to create a podcast.

Science

In Term 5 we will be continuing with classifying animals but exploring more of the dangers to habitats such as deforestation and pollution. In Term 6 we will be exploring sound—how the ear works, how vibrations link to sound and what affects the volume and pitch. Explorer Dome will be invited in to support us with this topic.

History

Our history will cover the topic of Invaders over both terms. We will explore significant events and people as well as ways of life during the time of Roman, Anglo Saxon and Viking control of Britain. In Term 5 we will be hosting a Roman Wow day where the children become Roman soldiers for the day.

French

Our units will explore:
Shapes: naming 10 different shapes and saying how many there are.
I am able to: exploring 10 different hobbies.

Music

We will continue to learn pieces of music on the Ocarinas. The children will then explore how to write their own music and compose a Roman march.

Maths

Year 3—Fractions

add and subtract fractions, Partitioning the whole, Finding unit and non unit fractions of objects and amounts.

Money

pounds and pence including converting, Adding and subtracting amounts of money, Finding change

Time

Units of time, Am or pm, Roman numerals, Telling the time to 5 and 1 minutes, Solving time problems.

Shape

Angles—right angles, comparing angles, measuring and drawing, Types of lines, Recognising, drawing and making 2D and 3D shapes.

Statistics

Interpreting and drawing pictograms, bar charts and 2 ways tables.

Year 4—Decimals

Tenths and hundredths as fractions and decimals, dividing a 1 or 2 digit number by 10 and 100, compare/order/round decimals.

Money

Write money using decimals, convert between pounds and pence, compare amounts of money, estimate money, calculate money and solve money problems.

Time

Years/months/weeks/days, hours/minutes/seconds, convert between analogue and digital time, convert to and from the 24 hour clock.

Shape

Understand angles as turns, identify and compare and order angles, triangles, quadrilaterals, polygons, lines of symmetry, complete symmetrical patterns.

Statistics

Interpret and draw charts and line graphs.

RE

We will be looking at the events of Pentecost and how the disciples might have felt. We will also be thinking about what type of world Jesus would want and the Kingdom of God.
