

PE

Invasion games are the focus in PE, starting with rugby this term and then football next term. We will also be covering gymnastics including using a range of large apparatus and then moving onto dance next term.

Geography

The Geography curriculum introduces the students to the countries of the UK and their capitals, alongside the surrounding seas. They will expand their global awareness by learning about the seven continents, five oceans, and the Earth's seasons. Celebrations of Saint's Days and quizzes will help reinforce their knowledge in a fun and interactive way.

Science

We will be learning about animals including humans. Year 1 will be finding out about animal groups, animal diets, parts of the human body and the senses. The children will continue to learn about the seasons. Year 2 will be finding out about animal offspring, survival, exercise and healthy living. They will then move on to look at habitats.

RE

The children will be learning about how we celebrate our journey and others journeys through life. We will find out more about Humanism before focusing on why Easter is important to Christians.

French

All children have a weekly French lesson. We will be learning all about 'In our town' and 'In the Jungle'.

Art

Students will study the work of Nick Mackman. They will learn to manipulate clay to create animal sculptures in the style of this artist. In term 4, children will be learning to use a running stitch when sewing to create an Easter decoration.



Computing

Pupils will be using digital programming to find out about algorithms. The Year 1 children will be using Beebots along with Scratch Jr. Year 2 will be developing their programming skills on Scratch Jr. The children will continue to learn about e safety throughout computing.

PSHE

The topic "Dreams and Goals" will encourage students to reflect on their ambitions, set achievable targets, and build resilience. In Term 4 we then move onto "Healthy Me" where we will be finding out how to stay safe and healthy.

English

We will be starting this topic with a Fairy Tale Wow Day. Children are diving into traditional tales using the Talk for Writing approach, allowing them to explore storytelling techniques. They will then be creating their own fairy tale story. Following on from this they will study animal-themed poetry and write non-chronological reports about animals, enhancing their descriptive and informational writing. This will link to our Geography topic "Our World".

Maths

Pupils in Year 2 will start by learning about money, including recognising coins and calculating amounts. This is followed by an extensive unit on multiplication and division. Year 1 children will be exploring place value, counting, ordering and comparing numbers to 20 and then 50. The children will then go on to look at addition and subtraction within 20. Year 1 and 2 will then explore measurement.

Music

In Term 3 and 4, children will be learning some more songs from Charanga and they will use percussion instruments to explore the beat.
