- c. Inform parents of the children's progress at Parent Consultation Meetings and in the End of Year Report.
- d. Inform parents about what the teachers aim to teach the children.
- e. Expect children to complete their homework and read at home for a minimum of five times a week.
- f. Instruct children how to use the internet safely.

- f. Wear the correct St Martin's School Uniform.

Family: We will:

- a. Make sure our child arrives at school on time and is collected promptly at the end of the day.
- b. Make sure our child attends regularly and the school is provided with either a note or telephone call with an explanation if they are absent
- c. Attend Parent Consultation Meetings to discuss our child's progress twice yearly or arrange another time if necessary.
- d. Support our child with their homework and ensure that they read at home for a minimum of five times a week.
- e. Support the schools policy on Behaviour and Anti-bullying.
- f. Support the school in E Safety by ensuring our child uses the internet and technology safely and appropriately.
- g. Support the school in sending our son/daughter in the correct St Martin's school uniform.
- h. Ensure that payments are prompt and up to date (e.g. School Lunches).
